5. Review and discuss an informational briefing regarding EB Arrow's planned redevelopment of the former Parkland Hospital Campus, approximately 38 acres of land adjacent to the Southwestern Medical TIF District.

- 6. Review and consider an amendment to the Southwestern Medical TIF District Project Plan and Reinvestment Zone Financing Plan to:
 - a. Create two sub-districts within the Southwestern Medical TIF District ("Zone"): (1) Southwestern Medical Sub-district (original Zone boundary) and (2) Medical Campus Sub-district;
 - b. Increase the geographic area of the Zone to add approximately 118.9 acres to create the Medical Campus Sub-district to accommodate anticipated redevelopment;
 - c. Establish a termination date for the Medical Campus Sub-district of December 31, 2045;

- d. Reduce the percentage of tax increment contributed by the City of Dallas during the remaining term of the Southwestern Medical Sub-district from 80% to 45%;
- e. Establish the percentage of tax increment contributed by the City of Dallas during the term of the Medical Campus Sub-district at 80%;
- f. Increase the Zone's total budget from \$27,550,486 Net Present Value (NPV) (approximately \$46,059,711 total dollars) to \$92,621,769 NPV (approximately \$153,885,868 total dollars), an increase of \$65,071,283 NPV (approximately \$107,826,157 total dollars);
- g. Restructure the Zone's budget to consolidate and broaden categories of eligible project costs in the Southwestern Medical Sub-district and add new budget categories for the Medical Campus Sub-district;
- h. Provide a one-time transfer of collected and unallocated TIF funds in the Zone to the Medical Campus Sub-district in an amount not to exceed \$8 million dollars no later than December 31, 2022; and
- i. Make corresponding modifications to the Zone's boundary budget and Project Plan and Reinvestment Zone Financing Plan.
